ADA COUNTY CHARGING STATIONS

Idaho Sierra Club – Downtown

- No fee for parking or energy
- 1 level 2 charger on the west wall of their office.

Whole Foods – Central Addition

- No fee for parking or energy
- 2 fast DC chargers in front parking lot

Boise State University

- Pay for parking, but energy is free
- 2 level 2 chargers in the Lincoln Parking garage on the ground floor, north wall
- 2 level 2 chargers in the Brady Street parking garage on the ground floor, north west corner
- 1 level 2 charger with two plugs on the street, east of the Student Union Building

Boise Airport

- 2 level 2 chargers on the second floor in the long term parking

Southwestern Idaho Electrical JATC, 121 E. 34th Street, Garden City

- 1 level 2 charger
